

In addition, businesses have the flexibility to extend and configure the CMS to meet their exact needs. The community development model of open source enables Red Hat to deliver a CMS with more features at a lower cost to the customer since the the product can leverage the work of open source Java developers, customers, professional services, and community developers. Red Hat's engineering organization integrates these contributions and performs quality assurance, scalability testing, and release management for the product.

A feature-rich software package, Red Hat Enterprise CMS sets the standard for a pure Java solution that enables content creators to organize and manage Web content through an easy to use Web interface. Sophisticated workflow, lifecycle, categorization, user-management capabilities, and a full package of templates for a variety of content types are delivered with the system.

Content creation

- Form-based interface for developing structured content consisting of text, images, and other binary assets
- Provides a standard content contribution wizard for authors to follow with integrated role-based permissions
- Integrates with numerous file formats
- Supports user-defined content types and pre-populated content types
- Supports multi-level categorization, separate navigation, and key word taxonomy support

Content templates

- Supports an unlimited number of custom content templates deployed using XSL Style Sheets with publishing to any channel (e.g., Web, WAP, etc.)
- Allows upload of HTML templates created in common authoring tools
- Content items can be authored in multiple languages
- Includes Form Builder (UI for creating online forms)

Content management

- Separates content, structure and presentation
- Centralized content repository with library services including versioning, archiving, content repurposing, and deployment
- Search and browse site content with advanced search across syndicated content

Workflow management

- Provides a customizable, role-based workflow engine
- Enables routing, e-mail notification, task assignments, and documents a full audit trail
- Includes reporting capabilities to determine content state and user-assigned task status

Metadata

- Supports Dublin Core metadata

User interface

- Features a default publishing interface
- UI can be customized to reflect local branding

Publishing

- Schedule content for publication and removal (manage content life cycle)
- Preview content items as they appear in all associated templates
- Full XML support and publishing through XSL Style Sheets to any channel

Administration

- Provides role-based permissions at multiple levels including content item granularity
- Provides security and permissions for users and groups; supports integration with LDAP authentication

Content syndication

- Supports RDF/RSS standards for syndicating content for external users. CMS can syndicate content and receive any RSS standard feed
- Enabled through user-configurable Web portal capability

Search and navigation

- Support for Intermedia on Oracle for full-text search of text and binary formats
- Support for open source Lucene search engine for database-independent searches
- Support for navigation to content based on categorization
