


What makes up a certified platform?

Each JBoss Enterprise Middleware platform goes through a 5 phase delivery methodology in its software development lifecyle:









The Evolution of Java EE







































Intelligent HTTP Load Balancing with mod_cluster

Intelligent software HTTP load balancer

Based on mod_proxy, mod_ajp

Load-balancing logic uses App. Server generated Metrics / Events

Memory Usage, active sessions, application disabled, server shutdown, etc.


8 Standard Metrics provided, write your own

Uses MCMP (Mod Cluster Management Protocol)

Uses Discovery to reduce static dependencies

JAX-RS - RESTful Web Services

JSR-311, JAX-RS – RESTful Web Services for Java

Annotation-based API for creating RESTful Java Web Services over HTTP

Simple, POJO-based

Included in Java EE 6

Includes client framework

Pluggable Providers

Fastinfoset, JSON, Multi-part, XML, Atom, YAML

Support for GZIP content-encoding

Hibernate Search

RDBMS / SQL not designed for *free-text* queries

No standard way to support word-stemming, sounds-like, synonyms, term-vectors, queries inside BLOBs

Apache Lucene – no domain model – just Document

Hibernate Search

Flexibility of *free-text* search

Power of Hibernate Domain model

Takes care of Index maintenance


