---

## AT A GLANCE

- Buy RHEV for Servers on a per managed-socket per year subscription
  - No costly “Editions” that force you into expensive upgrades to get a feature you need
  - No “vRAM” licensing or limits - Use as much vRAM in your virtual machines as you need without paying more
  - RHEV Manager included with subscription - no need to purchase separately; deploy as many as you need
  - Just count your hypervisor sockets, choose your SLA, and go.

## RED HAT ENTERPRISE VIRTUALIZATION FOR SERVERS SUBSCRIPTION MODEL

Red Hat Enterprise Virtualization for Servers (RHEV for Servers) subscription pricing is based on the number of managed sockets, providing customers with a straightforward model for ordering, deployment, and capacity planning.

With RHEV for Servers there is a single product with all the RHEV features included. All you need to choose is the service level (Standard business hours support or Premium 24x7 support). There are no crippled small business editions, and no need to purchase a more expensive edition.

RHEV for Servers does not charge extra for vRAM. We believe that customers should be able to use as much memory in their virtual machines as they need without worrying about having to buy additional licenses for memory usage.

The RHEV for Servers subscription requires a subscription to Red Hat Enterprise Linux for each RHEV Manager server to be deployed (sold separately).

- Red Hat Enterprise Virtualization for Servers Premium (24x7 support)

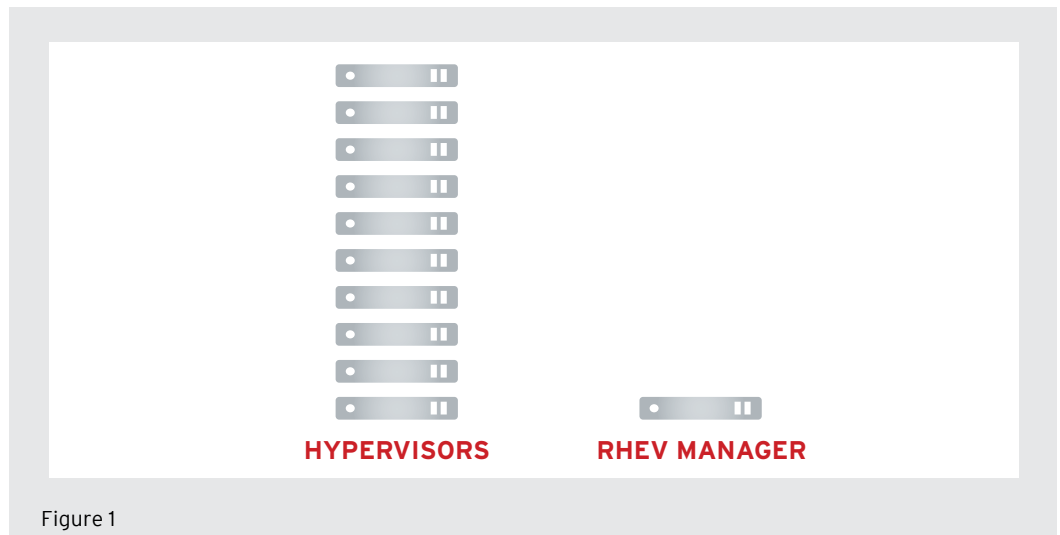

### THREE EASY STEPS

1. Count the number of sockets on your managed servers
2. Choose your support level (Business hours or 24x7)
3. Purchase that many RHEV for Servers subscription in either Standard or Premium

### PRICING EXAMPLE

Purchasing RHEV for Servers is easy. Here is an example: This customer has ten (10) servers with two (2) sockets each running as hypervisors, and a single two (2) socket server for the RHEV Manager. The customer is deploying in production and wants 24x7 support. (See Figure 1 below.) We only need to count the sockets on the 10 hypervisor servers, (20 sockets total), and then select RHEV for Servers Premium because we need 24x7 support.

Assuming the customer already has the Red Hat Enterprise Linux subscription for the RHEV Manager server, this customer now needs to purchase:

**20 Red Hat Enterprise Virtualization for Servers, Premium**

No Editions, No vRAM, No Limits. Red Hat Enterprise Virtualization for Servers makes purchasing virtualization simple. Finally.
