Red Hat Enterprise Directory Services and Authentication (RH423) is an intensive course designed to train senior system administrators on the skills required to manage and deploy Red Hat Directory Server on and for Red Hat Enterprise Linux systems. This course also covers crossplatform integration of directory services in order to provide authentication or information services across the enterprise. In addition, students will gain an understanding of the basic concepts, configuration, and management of LDAP-based services. This course also explores PAM, the Pluggable Authentication Modules system, and how it integrates with services that require authentication.

**Note:** A current RHCE certification is required to take the corresponding certification exam, Red Hat Enterprise Directory Services and Authentication Expertise Exam (EX423).

- Experienced Linux system administrators responsible for user account information and secured enterprise authentication mechanisms of one or more Linux systems
- System administrators who have configured directory services and authentication on other operating systems but now want to perform those tasks on a Linux system
