Migrating to OpenShift would provide customers with a trusted, consistent and comprehensive modern, hybrid-cloud application platform for deploying and running critical virtualized and container-based workloads side-by-side within a single platform.

Establishing transformation with best practices

With AWS as Red Hat's main internal cloud provider—and TGS an AWS Premier Tier Services Partner—a shared partnership with AWS made sense from both a technology and a consulting services perspective. TGS has expertise and capabilities in helping customers at any point in their cloud journeys, and adopting Red Hat OpenShift Service on AWS aligns with Red Hat's other enterprise initiatives.
